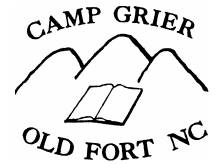

Dear Camper/Parent,

I am glad that you have registered for Summer Camp 2008. There will be a lot of new and exciting things happening at Camp Grier this summer. Registration will be between 1:30 and 3:00 p.m. on opening day and your camp experience will begin with getting settled into your cabin and gathering for supper.

PLEASE LEAVE AT HOME: ALL ELECTRONIC DEVICES INCLUDING GAME BOYS[®], TAPE PLAYERS, WALKMANS[®], TAPES, CELL PHONES, PAGERS AND SNACKS. TOBACCO PRODUCTS, ALCOHOL, AND DRUGS ARE NOT PERMITTED UNDER ANY CIRCUMSTANCES.

Please do not bring any children's non-aspirin pain reliever, Benadryl[®], or other over the counter drugs as camp supplies these items as needed. Any medication or over the counter drugs that you bring will be turned over to the First-Aid Coordinator at registration. Medications must be in the original container with the child's name and recommended dosage on the label. Parents, please write child's name, drug name, and dosage for over-the-counter drugs. Please put all medications in a Ziplock bag. They will be returned to you on departure day.

Camp is sometimes a child's first experience away from home and the staff at Camp Grier wants their stay to be very positive. Homesickness is real and is most disturbing to other campers. Please talk to your camper before arrival at camp about homesickness and that, yes, you will miss them, but that they will have a wonderful experience, have a great time, and meet many new friends.

Campers do not have access to a telephone; however, in case of an emergency you may reach your child at (828) 668-7793. VERY IMPORTANT: Please send a photocopy of your child's insurance information with their health form. Should the camper require medical assistance, this will make the process much easier and quicker.

DEPARTURE: Rising Suns leave after closing worship, which begins at 2:00 p.m. on Wednesday. All other campers leave after closing worship, which begins at 2:00 p.m. on Friday. Parents and friends are invited to attend all closing worships which will last no longer than 30 minutes.
